**ADVISORY OPINION NO. 1991-27**

**December 9, 1991**

**SUBJECT:** CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION DISCLOSURE REPORT DUE FIFTEEN DAYS BEFORE GENERAL ELECTION

**REAL OR HYPOTHETICAL SET OF CIRCUMSTANCES:**

No election is held (pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 21-2-545 or O.C.G.A. § 21-3-410) because there is no opposed candidate. Must the unopposed candidates file a campaign contribution disclosure report fifteen days before the date the canceled election would have been held?

**ADVISORY OPINION**

When no election is held, the unopposed candidates are not required to file a campaign contribution disclosure report fifteen days before the canceled election would have been held. However, not later than December 31 candidates are required to file a campaign contribution disclosure report which discloses all campaign contributions and expenditures.
